

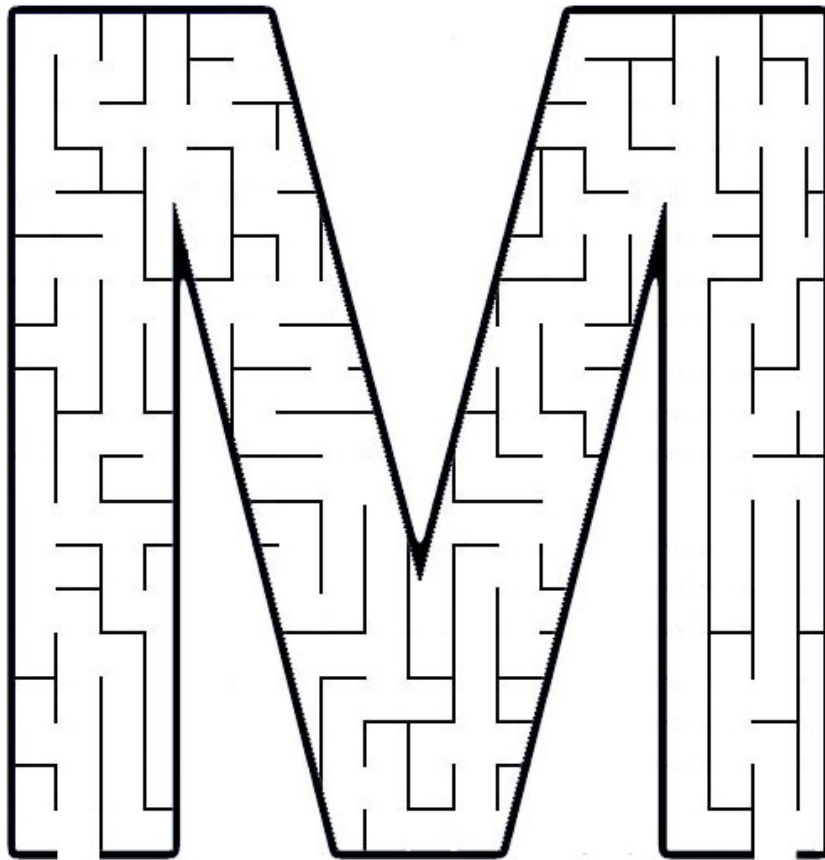
A-MAZE-ING WOMEN OF STEM: MATHEMATICS



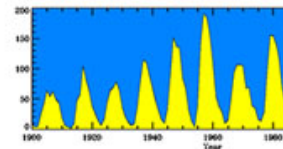
Jeanette Scissum was a mathematician. In 1967, she wrote a report about how to use mathematics to better predict sunspot cycles.
